Guidelines for Academic and Creative Writings

When you present the academic or creative writing in order to publish it in the '*Haritha Viyana*' blog, following guidelines are required to follow.

- 1. You should present your academic or creative writing under an environmental-oriented theme. Contemporary-relevant themes will be given priority.
- 2. You can present your academic or creative writing either Sinhala or English medium.
- 3. The maximum number of words for an academic or a creative writing should be not more than 1000.
- 4. You should present a suitable and enthusiastic theme for your academic or creative writing. The theme should be not a longer one and if it is a Sinhala writing, it is preferred to be presented the English translation of the theme too.
- 5. You can use few sub-topics within your academic or creative writing.
- 6. You should use Unicode for Sinhala writings as wells simple font style for English writings.
- 7. You can use a picture or maximum of three pictures which are relevant to your academic or creative writing. If you can use your own pictures, it is highly motivated, otherwise, mention the relevant sources if you retrieved pictures from the internet or any other source.
- 8. At the end, you need to mention the referces of materials you have used while preparing the academic and creative writing.
- 9. You need to use the language precisely within the academic or creative writing. Concern the stuffs like spellings and grammar.
- 10. You will be able to publish your academic or creative writings which have followed above-mentioned guidelines and after reviewing by the Green Hub editorial panel.
