12	Highlights	Highlights are a concise group of bullet points that summarize the main conclusions of the article and give readers a rapid textual summary. These bullet points summarize the main topics of the study (such as the findings or conclusions) and draw attention to its unique features. Highlights are optional yet highly encouraged for this journal, as they increase the discoverability of your article via search engines. Maximum up to five (Sinhala medium manuscripts also need to submit highlights in English.)
13	Abstract	Maximum up to 250 words. (*Sinhala medium manuscripts also need to submit abstracts in English.)
14	Include keywords	Maximum up to six.
15	Subdivision- numbed section	Divide your article into clearly defined and numbered sections. Subsections should be numbered 1.1 (then 1.1.1, 1.1.2,), 1.2, etc.

16	1.0 Introduction / හැඳින්වීම	State the background of the study, problem statement, objectives, literature reviews, limitations & significance of the study.
17	2.0 Materials and Methods / කුමවේදය	Should give an overview of the tools, techniques, and tools employed, as well as how the study was carried out, how the data was obtained and what statistical methods used to analyze the data.
18	3.0 Results and Discussion / පුතිඵල සහ සාකච්ඡා	Results should be clear and concise and it can be exploring the significance of the results of the study
19	4.0 Conclusions / නිගමන	The main conclusions of the study may be presented in a short Conclusions section, which may stand alone or form a subsection of Results and Discussion section.
20	References / ආශිුත ගුන්ථ නාමාවාෘලිය	References should be in APA 7th edition style. Where relevant, the following information must be included: author(s) name(s), journal title(s), book title(s), chapter title(s), article title(s), year of publication, volume number(s), book chapter, and article number(s) or pagination. [Use APA 7 Referencing Style, 11 Points, Regular, Line Space 1, Right Intend, justify]
21	Tables / Đφ	Tables should be clear and legible. Each table should have a brief title, which should appear at the top of the table with the table number. [Fonts 08 points, regular, line space 1, centered] Sours must mention in the below
22	Figures /රූපසටහන්	All graphical illustrations, flow charts, line drawings etc. are considered as figures. Number and the title of the figures should be indicated below them. [Font 11 points, regular, line space 1, centered] Sours must mention in the below
23	Word limit:	4000-8000 words including references and appendices
