## Basic information and common guidance for applicants

- 1) The attached application form should be completed accordingly and sent to the Course Coordinator, Diploma in Psychology, Department of Philosophy and Psychology, University of Sri Jayewardenepura via registered post or can be handed over to the Department of Philosophy and Psychology before 20/02/2024. The medium should be indicated on the corner of the envelope. Also indicate "Diploma in Psychology 2024/2025" on the top left-hand corner of the envelope. Applications received after the due date will not be considered for any reason.
- 2) Course fee and other charges:
  - Course fee- Rs. 65,000.00 (Payments can be made in two installments. First Installment is Rs. 45,000 and it should be paid on the registration)
  - Registration fee Rs. 1,000.00
  - Application fee Rs. 500.00 (Payment can be made through any People's Bank branch to 01301000177. The payment slip should be sent along with the application form)
- 3) Entry Qualifications
  - Passed the GCE (A/L) Examination in three (3) subjects OR
  - Passed the GCE (A/L) Examination in two (2) subjects and is accredited with one year or more of work experience OR
  - The applicant must possess a fully certified NVQ Level 4 qualification from a recognized institution (Related to any certificate course)
- 4) Copies of the following certificates should be attached to the application form and the original copies should be provided at the interview:
  - a. Copy of Birth Certificate
  - b. Copy of National Identity Card
  - c. Copy of A/Level Result sheet.
  - d. 2 copies of passport size photographs
- 5) The selected applicants will be informed after the interview in written and payments for the course should be deposited afterward.
- 6) The diploma program will be conducted every Sunday at 8:30 am, and lectures will be

held both online and onsite at the University premises. The decision regarding the course will be made by the Course Coordinator, and candidates must agree to abide by those decisions.

7) The course runs for a year and is comprised of two semesters.
